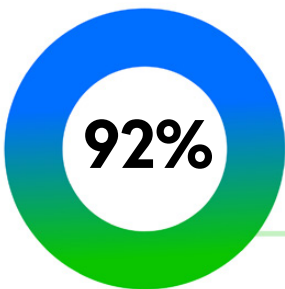

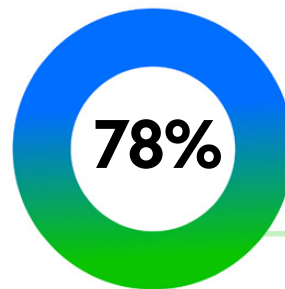

Advancing your career through Nacha accreditation enhances professional credibility, strengthens your organization's risk management profile, demonstrates to Regulators your organization's commitment to compliance, and ensures effective use of the ACH Network.

Accredited ACH Professional (AAP)

The AAP designation recognizes individuals with comprehensive ACH expertise and a broad understanding of the payments system. Any payments professional can pursue this credential. Nacha requires at least one year of industry experience before taking the exam and recommends two years. Candidates without one year of experience may request a waiver with employer or Payments Association approval.

Accredited Faster Payments Professional (AFPP)

AFPP accreditation demonstrates mastery of faster payment systems, including Same Day ACH, RTP®, FedNow®, and Push-to-Card. This program is designed for stakeholders across the payments ecosystem—financial institutions, fintechs, regulatory bodies, and service providers—who seek advanced knowledge of faster payment rails and related concepts.

Accredited Payments Risk Professional (APRP)

APRPs are experts in risk management across ACH, check, wire, and card. This credential positions professionals as trusted advisors within their organizations and networks. Increasingly, organizations seek or require APRPs to strengthen compliance and mitigate risk, making this accreditation a valuable career asset.

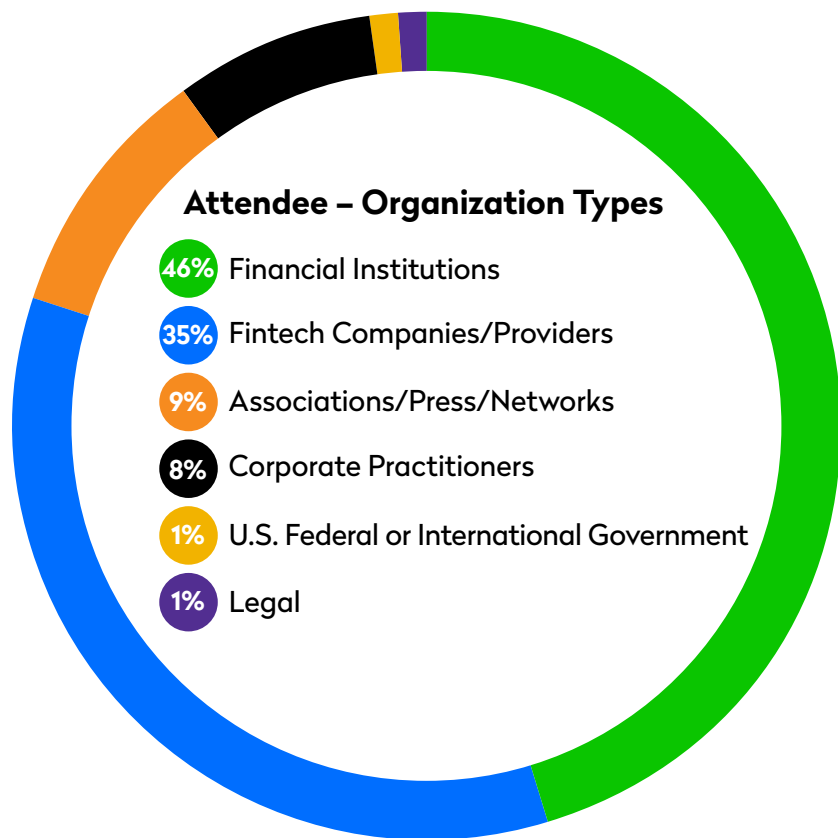
